The Iowa Center announced its 2022 Impact Results:

- 510 small business clients received 1:1 Business Coaching
- The Iowa Center empowered 21 new business starts, and creation of 52 new jobs
- Iowa Center Loan Fund disbursed 11 loans totaling \$307,650
- The Iowa Center led the Statewide Volunteer Incomes Tax (VITA) program which prepared 11,442 tax returns and secured \$18,502,920 in state and federal refunds for low-income Iowans
- The Iowa Center Loan Fund was certified as a CDFI, and The Iowa Center was certified as an SBA Microlender
- The Iowa Center opened its Eastern Iowa service office in Muscatine, Iowa
